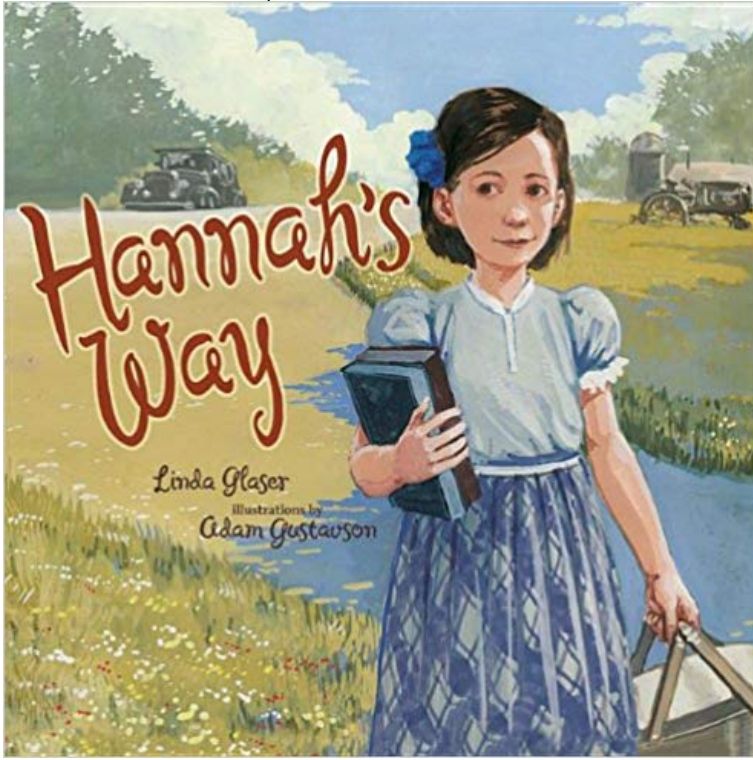


Hannah's Way
